Re: Character Reference for Jim Folsom. Case No.3:08-cr-01092-JAH

My name is Emmitt Luttrell, I am a 71 year old retired male. I am a retired Director of Manufacturing for a Division of Textron, a fortune 100 company. I am also a retired Material Manager for a Division of Crane, a fortune 500 company.

I have known Jim Folsom since 1995 and know his integrity to be impeccable. I was introduced to Jim, when my 33 year old son, in 1995, was diagnosed with cancer in St Paul MN. He had no job, no insurance and no money. A friend of mine introduced me to the bio-feedback frequency technology. I do not say it cures anything, but for some reason it lets or helps the body take care of the problem. If it had not been for the machine, my son would be dead today, but he is still very much alive and is a web master in Nashville, TN. He is willing to come to CA and testify, if need be. I have seen four of my immediate family members with cancer helped with this technology. It put in remission, or what ever you want to call it, but it stopped the cancer. When you have family members with cancer, it becomes a very personal matter.
