Re: Character Reference for Jim Folsom (case 3:08-cr-01092-JAH)

Dear Judge Houston, Sir,

This is a case that should trouble any decent man with a conscience.

My name is Keith Francis Scott, I am an Australian 62 years of age. My passport Number is E1017845, issued by the Department of Foreign Affairs, Australia, January 6, 2005. (copy herewith attached)

I am Executive Vice Chairman and Chief Financial Officer of Masi Corp Holdings Limited, a major asset management company registered in Fiji. I have a long history of public service and missionary work as well as a long and successful professional career.

I have known Jim Folsom since 1999, having been introduced to him by a mutual friend, Dr. Michael Van de Meer, a virologist whom I met in Philippines and in whom I confided when tests in Bangkok showed that I had advanced prostate cancer.

My mother died of cancer at the age of 63 and I saw her suffering as she went through chemotherapy, and I was with her during her passing. Having witnessed that, I decided it best not to suffer the same and sought an alternative method of dealing with this problem.

I purchased three machines from Jim Folsom, I gave one to a friend and another to a Dr. Phally, Doctor of Medicine in Cambodia. I have had remarkable success with my machine, I have no trace of cancer and I still use the machine regularly for all kinds of ailments, never traveling or going anywhere without it.

At a personal level, Jim Folsom is as fine a man as I have ever known, a man who is totally decent and sincere. Jim is a man of principle, a man who refused a deal that would have seen himself in much better current circumstances, all because he believes in what he does. He believes that people such as myself should have a choice in selecting our own medical care, as indeed is our right.

Jim Folsom may have sold many of these devices. I can only say that mine works splendidly and has done so for many years. I well understand why the medical fraternity and pharmaceutical manufacturers will do all they can to destroy men like Jim Folsom, as the money they could potentially lose if people treated themselves is incalculable. However, the fact remains, that if these devices sold by Jim Folsom do not work, then devices such as spectrophotometers do not work either. They have been trusted by the scientific community for many years because resonance is an understood, real and existing fact in science.

There is an underlying tragedy in this case. Not only is Jim Folsom a good and decent man being persecuted, but the American people and indeed the people of the world are being cheated by a callous medical fraternity who will stop at nothing to, as they claim, "protect the public" as these devices Jim Folsom has been selling would reduce their revenues in the same manner that these devices reduce the profits of pharmaceutical companies who mark up many medicines by as much as 200,000% to 350,000%, while the American people wonder how they can pay the cost of medical insurance. The truth is they are not protecting the public from anything. The truth is that they are only protecting their own financial position.

Law is easy to find in America. It seems Justice may well be a very different matter.

Like most people who know Jim Folsom, I am deeply saddened by the persecution he is subjected to, equally saddened by the ignorance of those who convicted him, as they know nothing of the reality of what he provides to people in need, nor were they allowed to know, and I am disgusted that American jurisprudence is as ruthless, unfeeling and uncaring as it is.

For me, this is no more than the brutal persecution of a good and decent man who provided me with the instrument that saved my life, a man who produces a machine that will never be accepted by the medical fraternity as it would reduce the money spent on health in the United States to a fraction, the same money you have to pay for medical insurance and that ordinary working people have to pay. The same money that goes to enrich pharmaceutical companies and medical practitioners.

It is a sad day for justice and truth, it is a worse day for the American People.
