Dear Judge Houston,

I have had the privilege to attend all nine of the International Rife Conferences that have been held since 1997. Speakers have included prominent university professors and researchers. I have hosted the last four conferences in Seattle. Up to 400 people from a dozen countries attend each time. The purpose of these conferences is to report on research being done on the use of frequency equipment and frequencies to benefit health.

Mr. Folsom has attended a number of these conferences and it has been my privilege to know him for several years.


I have been deeply saddened over the way Mr. Folsom has been treated. And I am concerned about some aspects of this case.

The prosecution has repeatedly talked about Mr. Folsom's customers being "victims." The customers themselves do not seem to consider themselves as victims.

Government officials have taken Mr. Folsom's property including books, historical videos and irreplaceable antique frequency equipment that they have asked permission to destroy. Why would anyone want to confiscate books and destroy them? Why would they want to destroy old video footage and equipment? Some of these items are evidence that Mr. Folsom's technology has been in existence much longer than the FDA and that it should have the benefit of "grandfathering". This is valuable historical and research material as well as being evidence.

I write to urge you to sentence Mr. Folsom to time served and to save his evidence.
